

# The Thrombectomy and Embolisation Prize Award for Trainees

## **Entry criteria**

The Prize Award is open to members of the BSIR who are trainees and Junior Consultants.

#### Content

Candidates will submit a written case study of 400-500 words, including relevant images of an interesting mechanical thrombectomy vascular or endovascular procedure or an interesting Embolisation procedure.

Entries will be accepted via email only to <a href="mailto:bsir.org">bsirt@bsir.org</a>

### Adjudication

All entries will be reviewed by one of our experts. The competition will be judged by using the following criteria:

- Originality
- Case description
- Quality of imaging
- Discussion

The winners will be announced at the annual meeting of the BSIR 1st-3rd November 2017 in Birmingham

Closing date for entries is midnight on 15th October 2017; no entries will be accepted after this time The decision of the judges is final.

#### **Prize**

The authors of the best two case studies, one for mechanical thrombectomy and one or embolisation, will be supported to attend the CIRSE meeting in September 2018.

The sponsorship comprises full registration.

In exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the organisers (e.g. if the candidate is taking part in an overseas fellowship at the time of the meeting) sponsorship may be provided to attend CIRSE the following year.

The entries will be judged, and the winners selected, by BSIR's clinical team.
