JUDKINS RIGHT
Access of right coronary



JUDKINS LEFT
Access of left coronary



HEADHUNTER CATHETER
Access to aortic arch vessels



AMPLATZ RIGHT
Access of right coronary



AMPLATZ LEFT
Access of left coronary



SIMMONS "SIDEWINDER" CATHETER
Access to mesenteric vessels and branches of aortic arch



MULTI-PURPOSE CATHETER
Wide range of use



PIGTAIL CATHETER
Useful in angiography of aorta and pulmonary trunk



COBRA CATHETER
Access to mesenteric, renal vessels and used in "crossing bifurcation" into contralateral Iliac

- Consent, skin preparation, antibiotic prophylaxis, local anaesthetic, sedation and contrast media.
