- Results
- Conclusion

The submission will be scored on:

- Quality of scientific methods and conclusion
- Clinical relevance to IO
- Study design – randomised controlled trials will score higher than prospective trials or retrospective case series

Please identify whether patient consent and institutional review board approval were granted. If no statement is made, it will be assumed that this has not been sought or given. Off-label use of any devices must be declared.

Please submit all audit, management and service review as a scientific submission.
